Dust Bowl Weekend 2009 MOTOR SCOOTER RALLY RELEASE & WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY, AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating in the 2009 Motor Scooter Rally, I represent that I understand the nature of motor scooter ride events and that I and/or my minor child am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity and upon which traffic hazards are to be expected. I acknowledge that if I and/or my minor child believe event conditions are unsafe, I and/or my minor child will immediately discontinue participation in the Activity. I fully understand that motor scooter ride events involve risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of other participating in the event, the conditions in which the event take place, or the negligence of the "releasees" named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my and/or my minor child's participation in the Activity. I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Tulsa Scooters, its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim. The applicant for a parade permit for a recreational purpose, and any other persons, organizations, firms, or corporations on whose behalf the application is made by filing the application, do represent, stipulate, contract, and agree that they will jointly and severally indemnify and hold the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma harmless against liability for any and all claims for damage to property, injury to, or death of persons arising out of or resulting from the issuance of the permit, or the conduct of the parade or its participants. I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT, and understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement of assurance of any nature and intend it be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that it any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect. I also hereby grant permission to the 2009 Dust Bowl Weekend Scoot Rally and Tulsa Scooters to use my photograph or likeness on any or all of the World Wide Web sites or in any other printed or electronic media publications without further consideration.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Each person attending is required to complete registration, regardless if they will be attending all or only some of the events, or if they will be participating as a passenger or a rider. \$35 registration fee includes rally pack, Saturday and Sunday breakfast, cookout on Sunday, and afterparty. Not included: Saturday lunch on the road, your gasoline, bail money, cheese puffs, etc.

Oklahoma Laws

- **No helmet law in Oklahoma with valid motorcycle license/endorsement. But please consider it!**
- **Must wear eye protection.**
- **Must have at least 1 mirror.**
- **Must have working head and tail lights, even during the day.**
- **Must have valid motorcycle license/endorsement or learner's permit.**
- **Must have current proof of liability insurance.**

Common Sense

You are responsible for your own actions, please drive safely around others.

If you don't have a motorcycle license/endorsement or insurance, that is your responsibility – but at least wear a helmet and proper riding gear and make sure the lights are working. It is also your responsibility to gas up before all rides.

Brush up on pack riding skills. It is up to each participant to make sure their vehicle is in the utmost of readiness. If someone breaks down HELP THEM! And let others know someone is down; we don't want anyone getting lost. The support truck will be behind us and they'll attend to any serious scooter troubles.

Please ask any Dust Bowl Weekend Scooter Rally volunteer or coordinator for transportation if you are intoxicated.
